## LE VOIR BIOGRAPHY



Falling on a genre spectrum somewhere between indie-tunesmith and electronic dance music, Le Voir, moniker of singer-songwriter and producer Gillian Chase, draws upon influences from contemporary synth rock as well as alternative and folk music. The artist's debut album, Dualities, represents Chase's dynamic musical style, moving back and forth between minimalistic, intimate moments and full electronic dance sections that bring acts such as LCD Soundsystem and M83 to mind. With plenty of vintage synth and bass layers contrasted against stripped acoustic elements, Dualities is as eager as it is vulnerable. Chase's full yet precise production and thoughtful sense of melody displayed on the self-composed album leaves plenty of room for Le Voir's live act to expand upon. Long time musical collaborator Rob Leo (guitar) and newcomer Clifford Moon (drums) complete the live line up, as Le Voir evolves into an exciting electronic rock trio. Leo brings emotive and powerful rock guitar riffs to the otherwise ethereal sounding synth textures provided by Chase, while Moon's live drum work adds a compelling organic element other electronic acts lack, driving the group through more experimental realms. From the album to the live experience, the sound of Le Voir feels vibrant, expressive and dance worthy.
